Today's Message: COLOSSIANS – JESUS: THE GREAT "MYSTERY" – Part 4

<u>Colossians 1:13 - 2:5</u> – The message of this section of the book of Colossians is:

- 1. God has provided everything that you will ever need through Jesus and His anointing.
- 2. Jesus' suffering and death were sufficient to pay the price for you to receive this great provision, with no additional sacrifice from you!

This section answers these questions:

- WHY did He send Jesus?
- WHO is Jesus?
- WHAT did Jesus do for us? WHAT does that mean for us?
- HOW does it manifest in us? HOW does it work for us?

Today's Message:

- vss. 21-23
 - What part of us was "hostile" towards God? (Our "mind" or soul)
 - Jesus paid the price and reconciled us to God and made us "holy and blameless"!
- vs. 24 Paul counts it a blessing to be persecuted for the sake of others being taught the Word!
- vs. 25 He eludes to his calling, which is: "to fully carry out the preaching of the Word of God."
- vs. 26 Paul equates the Word to a mystery "which has been hidden from the past ages and generations".
- vss. 26b and 27 But now it's God's will to <u>reveal</u> the mystery of the Word, which is "Christ in you, the hope of glory"!
 - What does "Christ in you" mean? (The Anointed One and His anointing inside you, in your spirit.)
- vs. 28 What was the goal of Paul's preaching?

"BUILDING the FAMILY of God, by BUILDING families in FAITH,..."



- wnat aoes complete in Christ mean?
- vs. 29 – "For this purpose"
Colossians 2
- vss. 1-2 – Why did Paul pray earnestly for those churches (believers) that he had not yet visited?
- Paul equates knowing God's mystery to!
- vs. 3 – We have in having Jesus Christ on the inside of us!
- What does that give us access to?
- vs. 4 – Why does Paul want to make sure that we get this point about Christ in us?
- vs. 5 – Paul is complimenting and encouraging the Colossians to exercise and
