Colossians 2: 6 - 23

- vs. 6 – Receiving Jesus is not all there is to “being” a Christian. *What else do we need to do?*
- vs. 7 – We need to be \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ Jesus!
  - *What does “established in your faith” mean?*
  - *What was Paul eluding to when he said, “just as you were instructed ...”?*
- vs. 8 – You can be \_\_\_\_\_ to philosophies and the deception that comes from traditions of men.  
“captive” = \_\_\_\_\_.
  - *What should impact our everyday lives more than philosophies and traditions?*
  - *What did Paul call the principles of the world and traditions of men?*
  - *How can these lead someone to being deceived by the devil?*
- vs. 9 – *Why is it better to follow the Anointing, rather than the principles of the world and the traditions of men?*
  - “For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells, in bodily form.”
