Colossians 2: 6 - 23

- vs. 6 – Receiving Jesus is not all there is to “being” a Christian. We need to learn to “walk in Him”!

- vs. 7 – We need to be firmly rooted and built up in Christ Jesus! We need to be “established” (building a foundation) through being taught to live by faith.

- vs. 8 – You can be captive to philosophies and the deception that comes from traditions of men.

“captive” = put in bondage; needing to be delivered from.

- The Anointing should impact our everyday lives more than philosophies and traditions!
- Paul called the principles of the world and traditions of men “empty deception”.

- vs. 9 – *Why is it better to follow the Anointing, rather than the principles of the world and the traditions of men?*

- “For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells, in bodily form.”
