<u>Colossians 2: 6 - 23</u>

- vs. 6 Receiving Jesus is not all there is to "being" a Christian. We need to learn to "walk in Him"!
- vs. 7 We need to be <u>firmly rooted</u> and <u>built up</u> in Christ Jesus! We need to be "established" (building a foundation) through being taught to live by faith.
- vs. 8 You can be captive to philosophies and the deception that comes from traditions of men.
 - "captive" = put in bondage; needing to be delivered from.
 - The Anointing should impact our everyday lives more than philosophies and traditions!
 - Paul called the principles of the world and traditions of men "empty deception".
- vs. 9 Why is it better to follow the Anointing, rather than the principles of the world and the traditions of men?
 - "For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells, in bodily form."
