

<u>II Timothy 1:9</u> (NASB) – (God) who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity.

<u>Ephesians 4:4</u> (tPt) – being one body and one spirit, as you were all called into the same glorious hope of divine destiny.

<u>Galatians 6:4</u> (tPt) – Let everyone be devoted to fulfill the work God has given them to do with excellence, and their joy will be in doing what's right and being themselves, and not in being affirmed by others.

Romans 11:29 (NASB) – for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

(tPt) – And when God chooses someone and graciously imparts gifts to him, they are never rescinded. (See footnote "h")

<u>I Corinthians 7:20</u> (tPt) – So everyone should continue to live faithful in the situation of life in which they were called to follow Jesus. (See footnote "f")

<u>Philippians 3:14</u> (NASB) – I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

<u>II Peter 1:10</u> (NKJV) – Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble.
